Anne Workman made a request for \$24.50 for second grade gifted students that are participating in the Great Mail Race to learn about other states. The money will be used to purchase 50 stamps. This will benefit 17 students. After discussion, this request was not approved.

### **Kindergarten and First Grade Teams**

The kindergarten and first grade teams made a special request for \$250 for an in house field trip to cover the cost of the Jack Hartman Concert. The concert is \$650 and the teams currently have \$400. Jack Hartmann is a children's performer who sings songs that are familiar to the students and are filled with math/reading skills and brain breaks. Concert is scheduled for Monday, March 14 and will benefit 210 students. Massie made a motion to approve. Allyson seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Food Services: Will be discussed by Robin Hagerty with OCPS Services

1. The bringing of food onto campus for celebrations. The Healthy School team run by OCPS has issued new procedures. A form must now be filled out by parents and a copy of ingredients listed in the item submitted with the form. I understand this is to help with food allergy issues as well as with possible cases of food born illness.
2. The no compete clause in school and food service contracts.
